NORTH TO ALASKA

Nome, Alaska, home to Eric Guthier, class of 2001. Nome is located in northwestern Alaska, just south of the Arctic Circle. It is the center of commerce, transportation, and government for northwestern Alaska. Nome is less than 200 miles from Russia, across the Bering Strait. The population in Nome is approximately 4,021, with 54% of those Alaska Native Eskimo.

Nome is host to the Bering Sea Ice Golf Classic, a six hole tournament played on the ice, the Polar Bear Swim, and the Midnight Sun Festival in June. It is a popular stop for tourists and bird enthusiasts, and in March is the finish line for the Iditarod Trail Sled Dog Race, which starts in Anchorage and ends in Nome, covering 1049 miles.

Situated on the Bering Sea coast, Nome is sur-

rounded by rolling hills of arctic tundra, dotted with a variety of miniature plants, berries and wildflowers. Due to an underlying frozen layer of permafrost, the landscape is naturally treeless, save for a few small transplants found in resident's yards.

No road system connects Nome to any other city. The longest local "road" (dirt and gravel) stretches 80 miles north, and then ends abruptly in the middle of the Seward Peninsula. There is no rail connection, and no buses. The only connection to the outside world is a 600 mile flight south to Anchorage.

So you must wonder how Eric ended up there and loves it.

Eric attended the University of Akron, majoring in Communications. In 2005, Eric moved to Nome to work at one of the two radio stations in Nome, KNOM 96.1.

He was the production director for the station as well as the morning DJ. His job responsibilities included flying out to native vil-



lages for news stories, cultural festivities, and sporting events, as well as producing on air spots and hosting a call in talk show. The job was a one year position and ended in 2006.

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He moved back to Mogadore in 2006 to complete his degree in Communications at the University of Akron. In 2008, he moved back to Nome permanently and currently works for the Department of Homeland Security.

He met his wife at the radio station in 2005 and after returning to Alaska in 2008, was married in 2009, in Nome.

His spare time is spent fishing for salmon, doing some photography, gathering berries on the tundra, traveling and seeing the vast state of Alaska, and enjoying the 24 hours of daylight in the summer.

LEADER, MOTIVATOR

The future of cross country and track and field athletics changed at Edinboro University when Doug Watts began coaching the sport in 1969. But before becoming a part of the coaching staff at Edinboro University, home of the Fighting Scots, Doug completed his degree from the University of Akron in 1964, majoring in Health and Physical Education. He was an assistant coach while attending Akron U. His first coaching job was at Walsh Jesuit High School, where he started the cross country program. His record during his two years at Walsh was 19-0 and a district title.

The Running Scots of Edinboro have experienced much success under the direction and leadership of Coach Doug Watts. Doug has produced numerous All-Americans and team championships, as well as four individual cross country champions and five individual track first-place finishers.

They have completed 33 consecutive undefeated cross country seasons and 124 straight dual victories. Doug's teams have produced a total of six national championships, including back-to-back-to-back NCAA Division II titles from 1986 through 1988, and backto-back NAIA titles in 1975 and 1976. His teams have earned six runner-up trophies, plus finishes of third (twice), fourth (three times), fifth, sixth (twice), seventh (three times), eighth (three times) and ninth.

The men's squads have accomplished 17 top-ten finishes at the national meet in the last 24 years. The women's program is credited with being one of the elite programs in the NCAA East Region and on the national stage.

Many "Coach of the Year" awards are found in Doug's office. He was inducted into the Edinboro Hall of Fame in 2004.

His personal accomplishments include the "National Coach of the Year", 5 times. He has published numerous distance-running articles for national publications. He has been nominated twice for an Olympic coaching position.

Doug has served as the Past President of the NCAA Division II Track and Field Coaches Association and former Vice President of the USTCA National Coaches Association. Also, he was the head of NCAA Division II Cross Country Hall of Fame Committee and has sat on the Board of Directors for the USTFCCCA (U.S. Track & Field Cross Country Coaches Association).

Each summer Coach Watts conducts a pre-season endurance training camp, the Edinboro Distance Village, for young men and women. Sixteen of his Edinboro athletes have been Olympic qualifiers.



EDINBORO'S CROSS COUNTRY PHILOSOPHY

"Generally we attract the middle distance athlete who is seeking a special environment for running," says head coach Doug Watts about his track and cross country programs at Edinboro University. A student athlete should consider Edinboro because of the following reasons;

I. A small school setting, academically oriented that generally allows for a fuller personal development in the classroom, athletic and social activities; yet it offers a large, diversified choice of educational majors and specialties.

- 2. A TEAM concept in training competition.
- 3. A distance-based training program integrating selected road races as a training supplement.
- 4. Division I schedule of intercollegiate competition.

5. A program that allows personal direction and individualism, a proper balance between academics and athletics...and fun.

6. A tradition of excellence and proven success in running within an environment supportive and respectful of distance runners.

MOGADORE SCHOOLS ALUMNI FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIP FUND

The purpose of the scholarship fund is to promote higher education to a deserving graduate or graduates of Mogadore High School. The recipient or recipients would be expected to complete his or her college education in such a manner as to bring credit to Mogadore High School.

- I. Establishment of the Fund
 - a) The Mogadore Schools Alumni Foundation will establish a nonrenewable scholarship fund for the purpose of promoting higher education.
 - b) The scholarship shall be set at a minimum of one scholarship per year for a sum of at least \$500.00, providing there are qualified applicants for the scholarship.
 - c) The scholarship will be funded through a combination of annual membership drives, dues, fund-raising activities, and charitable donations.
- 2. Selection Committee
 - a) The Selection Committee will consist of at least two members of the Alumni Foundation Scholarship Committee.
 - b) The Committee will meet no later than May 7th of each year for the purpose of reviewing the applications and selecting the recipient or recipients of the scholarship.
 - c) The decision of the Selection Committee is final and shall not be disputed.
- 3. Scholarship Entrance Criteria
 - a) All applicants must be graduates of Mogadore High School.
 - b) All applicants must be entered or plan to enter an accredited institution of higher learning which issues an associate degree or higher.
 - c) All applicants must submit with the application an essay, the length of which will be chosen by the applicant, which explains "How my experiences at Mogadore High School will enable me to succeed in college".
 - d) Factors to be considered in the selection of the recipients will be the essay, scholastic achievement, and any other information the applicant believes will be pertinent (extracurricular activities, copy of tran scripts, outstanding achievements, and the like).
 - e) Financial need is not a requirement, but may be considered in the selection process.
 - f) All applications including the essay must be submitted no later than the second Friday of April of each year directly to The Mogadore High Schools Alumni Foundation, I S. Cleveland Avenue, Mogadore, Ohio; 44260.
 - g) Payment will be made to the winner or winners of the scholarship upon proof of registration at an ac credited institution of higher learning.

In the event a recipient is not able to utilize his or her scholarship in accordance with said terms, conditions, restrictions, etc., the Scholarship Committee may, upon written notification of the recipient, modify the requirements on a case by case basis as deemed appropriate by the Selection Committee.

Any changes to this document must be approved by at least two members of the Alumni Foundation Scholarship Committee.
